Low cost secluded air conditioning for small spaces

Booming electricity bills are a source of constant worry, both for households and commercial establishments. In addition to the cost factor, what is intolerable is the huge amount of power and energy wasted in air-conditioning huge spaces. An innovative

UPCOMING EVENTS solution to this has been offered by Nagpur based entrepreneur Shivraj Shende, who came up with the idea of providing selective air-conditioning in small spaces, as and when required. In everyday life, huge business and residential spaces are being centrally air-conditioned. While this adds to the ambience and comfort of big corporates, the grassroots entrepreneurs as well as houses belonging to lower middle class bear the brunt of electricity bills unnecessarily. In many cases, only 1/4th of the area under air-conditioning is effectively used.



Shivraj Shende uses soft, cushion fabric made with environment friendly material that can enclose the area to be air-conditioned. This aesthetic enclosure comes in vibrant shades and sizes, with provisions to extend the same to smaller and bigger areas. This enclosure consist of a small window into which the air-conditioning unit blows chilled air. The unit is balanced with a sturdy steel tripod. For people to get in and out of the enclosure, one side of the enclosure is zipped and acts like a door. This whole make-shift structure is made light weighted and is absolutely portable, so that is can be carried to different places.

It is possible to keep the unit running for 3-6 hours and is perfectly safe to use, along with other electrical appliances. Initially, Shende's concept did not gain recognition, since people

So, it is way to go for this young and raring innovator, who made a honest and unassuming start to his entrepreneurial journey in the small industries space and is looking forward to scale-up operations.
